Mercy is an inspiring, ambitious, bright young lady, who was born with a spinal condition known as kyphosis or hunchback. She is academically an above average student who managed to obtain 7 points at grade 12. Her mother passed away a few years ago, while her father has never been present in her life.

She currently lives with her grandfather, Mr. Alfred Mulakwa, ex-Miner and fabricator in George Compound, Lusaka district.

Her grandfather does odd jobs and depends on good will to make ends meet. All her life, Mercy has wanted to become a medical doctor but had not been able to secure funding despite being accepted to two medical universities

MWAZ heard about Mercy's plea for financial aid and sponsorship to pursue her Medical Degree. MWAZ has assisted Mercy and her grandpa by providing her with the tools to make and sell keychains, for there upkeep.

MWAZ has also facilitated their integration into the National Zambian Social Cash Transfer List. Another organisation has since come on board and has pledged full sponsorship for Mercy to study medicine.

Three MWAZ medical students have since befriended Mercy and are mentoring her.

As MWAZ, we are elated that Mercy's dream is coming true. We will continue to inspire more girls to take up medicine as a career.

Reflections ZAMBIA MEDICAL ASSOCIATION (ZMA) AGM 2021

The ZMA 2021 Scientific Conference and Annual General Meeting was held from 10-11 th September 2021 at Avani Resort in Livingstone under the theme *"Collectively Investing in health and healthcare workers to protect the gains made against HIV in the advent of new biological threats."* The event was well attended by representatives from all over the country. The numbers of female doctors in attendance were also increased by the initiative of MWAZ through providing subsidized transport and accommodation. The ZMA was graced by the presence of the Minister of Health Honorable Sylvia Masebo MP. The AGM saw the voting in of a 2 new female ZMA executive members Dr. Patricia Shinondo asVice President and Dr Chileshe Mabula as Chair for medical education and research.





MWAZ took time to visit the SOS Children's Village orphanage to counsel the girls and encourage them to work hard in school and take up careers such as medicine upon graduation.

MWAZ donated sanitary pads to all the 72 girls and female staff. Mr. Zulu the director bemoaned the high cost of sanitary products as one of the major challenges the organization faces.

The 304 packets of sanitary pads were donated by Copperrose Zambia headed by Dr Natasha Kaoma a member of MWAZ.

This is the start of many more such donations which MWAZ will conduct to help alleviate period poverty in Zambia.
