

October - Cancer Awareness month



For breast screening, majority were found with normal breast exams while seven had abnormalities ranging from lumps, abnormal nipple discharge, and pain. These were given medication where necessary and also linked to the next level of care for further management.



Former First Lady, Ms. Maureen Mwanawasa and CDH Oncologist, Dr. Catherine Mwaba visited the MWAZ booth to encourage the doctors working.

October being the cancer awareness month, MWAZ, in collaboration with Teal Sisters Foundation and Maluba Rotary club, conducted breast cervical cancer screening women and girls in high compound, a residential area and Arcades shopping mall in Lusaka. We attended to a total number of 132 women, ranging from 12 to 61 years.

For cervical cancer screening, using Visual Inspection with Acetic Acid (VIA), 81 women were attended to; of whom 15 were found with positive lesions and referred for further management including Loop Electrosurgical Excision Procedure (LEEP).

On 1st December 2022, MWAZ joined the rest of the world in commemoration of World AIDS Day under the theme "Equalise! Closing the gaps".







The event was graced by the Honorable Ministers of Health & Education, Sylvia Masebo and Douglas Siakalima who visited the MWAZ booth.

MWAZ took part in a march past in Lusaka from ZESCO headquarters to Mulungushi International Conference Centre and distributed information leaflets to members of the public along the way. The Ministers visited our booth and commended MWAZ for being an active participant by raising awareness of the pandemic and distribution of free condoms to the public.

Monthly Webinars


Topic: Lung Health for all




